What are the symptoms of Coronavirus?	 Fever. New, continuous cough. Loss of smell & taste. 	https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus- covid-19/symptoms/
What should you do if you have Coronavirus symptoms?	 Book a test & stay at home until you receive the results. People who live with – or are in your support bubble – should also isolate until you receive your results. If they start to exhibit symptoms, they should also get tested. 	https://www.gove.uk/get-coronavirus-test
What must you do if you test positive?	 You must isolate at home for 10 days. If you don't, you could be fined £1,000.00. People you live with – or who are in your support bubble – must isolate at home for 14 days, even if they have tested negative or did not have a test. If they also tested positive, they need to isolate at home for 10 days from the day they became ill or were tested. By law, you must let your employers know that you have Coronavirus and must self-isolate. Your employers include the Employment Agency that hired you, as well as the owner of the business to which you have been assigned. Social distance as much as possible – stay 2 meters away from anyone you do not live with or are not in your support bubble.	https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus
Wash your hands frequently throughout the day with soap & water for at least 20 seconds each time.	
Use hand sanitiser when it is not possible to wash hands.	
Wear a face mask / covering in areas that you are required to. Wash hands before putting a mask on & after removing it.	
If you <u>must</u> work within 2 meters of anyone, avoid being face-to-face & wear a face mask, if possible. Try to limit the time that you are in contact to less than 15 minutes & work in a well-ventilated area.	
When travelling to work, wear a face mask when using public transport.
